### Music Lessons in School

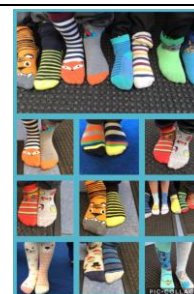
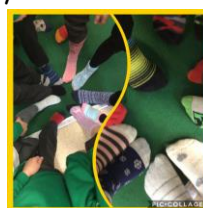
